



Club La Costa Contracts Declared Null



Court: First Instance Court, Fuengirola, Spain

Case Date: January 2025

Summary:

Fourteen timeshare claims were concluded against various resorts, including Club La Costa.

Key Findings:

- The courts found that the contracts lacked essential information, such as property details and contract duration, violating Spanish Law 42/1998.

Outcome:

The contracts were declared null and void. The total compensation awarded amounted to £304,665, with individual awards varying per case.

Impact:

These rulings reinforce the legal requirement for transparency in timeshare agreements and provide a precedent for other consumers with similar contract deficiencies
